This records the butterflies and moths at Worthy Down Station nature conservation site (SU 447980 135250).




The area covers the station and immediate surroundings.

A total of 17 butterfly and 2 moth species are recorded.

This represents a major achievement that provides evidence of the rich flora now existing at the old station and how biodiversity has manifested in the relatively short period since the beginning of conservation activities in 2006. It is testament to the work carried out by Worthys Conservation Volunteers and others.
