

Report

This 'bioblitz' records the wildflowers, grasses/sedges, other flora/fungi, birds, butterflies/moths, other insects, and other fauna identified at Top Field, Kings Worthy during the period from 16 July to 18 August 2020.

The picture is a of a wealth of interesting and attractive wildlife on the field, particularly around the edges but extending towards the middle as well. Some areas are being overtaken by scrub and bramble which needs to be controlled – although good things for birds, bees and butterflies.

A copy of the results has been sent to the ecologist at Winchester City Council (who will be managing the Field) and it was received with interest. Data has also been into Living Record.
